U.S.C.A. EXECUTIVE DIRECTOR

On January 13, 1979 at Dallas, TX the Delegates approved the USCA Reorganization Committee Report that was spearheaded by Jim Mack. Thus, the USCA officially started a new phase. The USCA now had a two tier organizational system - (1) Bylaws and (2) Rules and Regulations. The major change was that the new Bylaws would remain unchanged and would serve as the **Foundation of our Association**. Prior to that every time the Bylaws changed they had to be filed in the Indiana Not-For-Profit office. With the two tier system, the Rules and Regulations could be changed to fit our needs without going to the Indiana office to be filed every year. One of the new Duties of the Delegates had accepted in this reorganization, was that an Executive Director could be employed or appointed. We knew as the Association grew, the need for continuity would be needed. An Executive Director would serve this need.

On January 13, 1989 at Rockford, IL, the position of Executive Director was activated by the U.S.C.A. Board of Directors (Delegates) in accordance with the U.S.C.A. Rules and Regulations ARTICLE IV, Section 2 H. In ARTICLE III, Section 4, the list of requirements and duties are stated. In part, "The duty of the Executive Director is to serve as a leader in furthering the purposes of the Association; be responsible for seeing that the directions of the Delegates and the Executive Committee are carried out; Conduct the day-to-day business of the Association; Assist in maintaining continuity in the Association during officer or committee changes. Is a facilitator."

Jim Mack of Middletown, Ohio was immediately appointed to serve as the first Executive Director of USCA. Jim served as a non-paid volunteer until his resignation August 10, 2001. Jim had accomplished these duties and gave the United States Canoe Association a professional image and recognition among our peers in the PaddleSport World. We are pleased that Jim continues to serve as an advisor to the USCA.

At the 2002 USCA Annual meeting at Savannah, GA, John Edwards from St. Petersburg, Florida, stepped forward and accepted the position as USCA Executive Director. John has served the Association for over thirty years in many capacities including Delegate, USCA Vice President, USCA President, and the Chairman of many Standing Committees. He has been a USCA National Champion many times over and has competed internationally, as well. He brings to this position, a lot of experience and dedication to paddlesport and to United States Canoe Association.

John Edwards served as the Executive Director until a two year term of office rule was approved by the Delegates at the 2010 Annual Meeting. Due to this rule it was deemed that Edwards had already served four terms. A motion was approved to extend the term of Edwards as the Executive Director and postpone the appointment or employment of an ED until the 2010 Semiannual meeting. Edwards continued as the ED until he tendered his resignation on February 18, 2010.

A search to fill this position was done. Joe Shaw from Worthington, MA submitted his application to serve as the next USCA Executive Director. Shaw presented a summary of qualifications that included a lifetime of involvement in sports, including participation, instruction, coaching, administration, and promotion combined with thirty years business/ administrative experience in banking and financial consulting. His paddling experience covers thirty years in canoes, kayaks, outrigger canoes, surfskis, dragon boats and swan boats. Shaw has been a member of the USCA and participated at local, regional and national races. He also has served as a USCA Kayak Committee member and Chairman of the USACK Marathon Racing Committee.

At the Semiannual Meeting held at Peshtigo, WI, the Board of Directors (Delegates) appointed Joe Shaw to the position of USCA Executive Director.

USCA WEB SITE and USCA WEBMASTER

On May 27, 1997 at 5:15 p.m., the USCA Website was born. The address was the following: <<http://usca-canoe-kayak.org>> The Webmaster, Josh Thomas of Vermilion, OH, was 15 when he developed this website for USCA. Since it's inception, the "pages" have grown and the site provides race and cruise schedules, race results, Nationals information, a membership application, and links to various comparable groups and clubs. A private chat line within the website is available.

On August 11, 2000, Josh announced that the USCA website address would change to www.USCAnoe.org which offered free e-mail, interactive calendar, auction block, classified ads, instant news, message board and chat. On August 12, 2000, the site was activated. Josh's talent in computers and interest in USCA was a great asset to USCA. This was the foundation for the website information with its many links and remained a benefit to the paddlesport world.

In 2002, Jim Dipelesi of Kings Park, NY assumed the duties as Webmaster. His work to continue to improve the web site and offer more information, contacts, links and other valuable information was complicated when it was discovered that another group had taken over our website without our knowledge. The situation was quite upsetting for a while and required USCA to quickly obtain a new web site. The new site became www.USCAnoe.com. The old web site may still be there, but be careful. You won't like what you can link into or possibly receive later even though it looks authentic with the USCA name, logo and nationals race pictures.

Jim worked extremely hard to get the new site up and running quickly. We were pleased once again to have such a dedicated, knowledgeable member who volunteered to provide a great service to USCA and all the paddlesports world.

In 2003, Jim excitedly emailed one and all that our old web site with ".org" might be available.. but, he had to wait 45 days. Well, in 45 days, the old web site was snatched out of his hands. He continued his review of the site to put in his bid when and if it became available again. (It never happened.)

From then on, the USCA web site has been www.USCAnoe.com. Jim had expanded the amount of space on the web site so that more information could be provided. There was a new and improved USCA web site to serve us.

USCA WEB SITE and USCA WEBMASTER (Continued)

For the next six years, information that was made available on this website increased. About every document that has been created for the Association is available on the website. This includes the USCA Competition Rules and Canoe Specifications, the USCA Bylaws, Rules and Regulations and a multitude of other documents including 'How to Host the Nationals' and other 'How to' manuals. Race schedules and applications for the Nationals for each year are included or linked to the Nationals Race Sponsor websites. There is a link to the USCA Insurance Program information and Forms for Sanctioned Race Sponsors and Club Affiliates. 'Join USCA' brings up a Membership application which now links to a pay online service, if desired. Race results from the Nationals are posted along with lots of pictures. Many years of Nationals information and results are archived on the website. Jim also featured articles submitted by many members and pleaded for more to provide articles. Another item available on the website was a one page brief review about the USCA CANOE NEWS. Creating and maintaining this website was mainly done by this one volunteer.

At the 2008 Annual Meeting, the USCA Canoe News Editor, Gareth Stevens, outlined plans to create a series of at least eight web pages which would replace the one page available on the current www.uscanoe.com website and would link to it. At the 2008 Semiannual Meeting, it was announced that the *Canoe News* website was under construction. It was named, uscanoe-news.com. As planned, it would link to the main website.

On July 26, 2009, the USCA's Publications Committee announced that the launch of the new USCAnoenews.com and its centerpiece, the new Worldwide Paddling Event Calendar. The many features of this website were listed in the USCA Canoe News publication, Volume 42/issue 3.

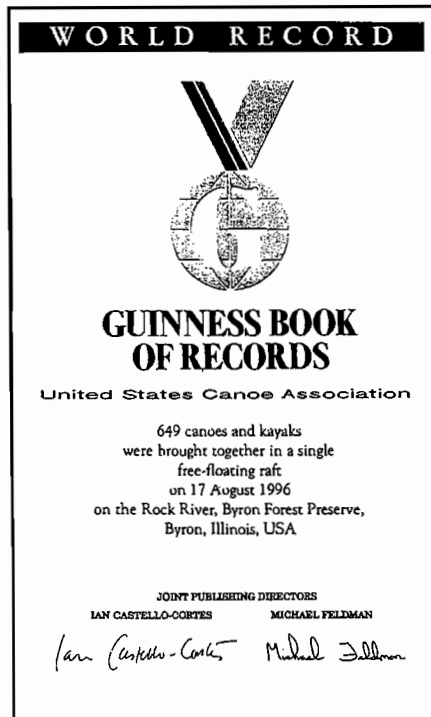
On October 2, 2009, Jim Dipelesi resigned as the Webmaster and Web site Chairman of the main website. Gareth Stevens was immediately appointed to fill these positions. Stevens also continues to serve as the chair of the Canoe News website, <http://www.uscanoenews.com>. This second website is listed as an integral part of the main website.

GUINNESS RECORD SET

On August 17, 1996 at Byron, IL, 649 craft of all sorts remained connected in a free float for over one minute. We were connected with hands on gunnels from one craft to another or holding onto some part of an adjacent craft in the flowing, Rock River. To show that we were floating freely, all paddles were held high in the air. Even though only 30 seconds is officially recorded in the 2000 Millennium Guinness Report, the minute plus was actually achieved.

Why did we do this? The USCA wanted to do something significant in the paddlesports world to bring all paddlers together. What better way to bring paddlers together than to try to set a world record for the most craft in a free float? And, WE DID IT! USCA still holds the World Record. A certificate was presented to recognize that the United States Canoe Association set a World Record in the Guinness Book of Records.

Jim Mack was instrumental in organizing this project and filed all the official documents, but it took the work of lots of people to accomplish this goal. The helpers on land and those on the 649 craft should be proud to have established this World Record. A reduced copy of the certificate which appeared on the cover of the *USCA Canoe News* is displayed below.

GREG BARTON K-1/C-1 JUNIOR MARATHON CUP CHALLENGE WINNERS

Junior paddlers from the ages of 9-17 as of January 1 of the current year are encouraged to qualify at various races throughout the country in any K-1 or USCA C-1 marathon event. The age groups are 9-11, 12-14, and 15-17 for both girls and boys.

The Challenge was initially approved by the USCA Delegates in January, 2000 to promote junior paddling opportunities in the ICF Kayak and USCA C-1 cruiser throughout the paddling season. Greg Barton was an Olympic K-1 Champion who got his start paddling in the USCA. USCA would like to develop more paddlers to follow in the paddle strokes of Greg Barton. In 2006, the delegates modified the rules so that juniors may qualify in any kayak not just the ICF K-1 and/or the USCA C-1. Paddlers can choose any approved qualifier race site to compete in regardless of where they live. Medals will be awarded at these sites to the top three winners in each class.

In 2006, the USCA Delegates reduced the distance of qualifier races from the previous five up to ten miles to a minimum of three miles, depending on the site.

The finals for the Barton Cup Challenge will be held at the USCA National Marathon Canoe and Kayak Championship in the K-1 Junior and C-1 Junior events for ages 9 to 17. The Greg Barton Cup (a non-revolving trophy) will be awarded to the overall fastest "qualified" girl and overall fastest "qualified" boy in K-1 and C-1. First through third place medals will be awarded in all classes at the finals. Each participant at the Nationals will receive a Tee shirt or other award determined by the Barton Cup Challenge Committee.

"Qualified" is any junior who has participated in at least one qualifying race prior to the USCA National Championships and competes in that event at Nationals. If the junior had qualified in both C-1 and K-1 prior to Nationals, the junior may compete in both events and be eligible for the Cup in each event.

The Barton Cup Challenge program is administered by the USCA Barton Cup Challenge Committee, a sub-committee of the Youth Activities Committee. Any USCA Sanctioned Race Sponsor may offer a qualifier race on their schedule. Contact the Barton Cup Committee Chair or the Youth Activities Chair prior to the event so the race will be an official qualifier race. Qualifier sites are listed on the USCA web site.

YOUTH ENCOURAGEMENT AWARD

At the 2004 USCA Annual Meeting, the Delegates approved the establishment of this annual award in order to recognize the U.S.C.A. member who is found to have made an outstanding contribution to encourage youth into competitive canoe paddling. The proposal was made by Larry Liquori, a delegate from the New York Division/USCA who was appointed to oversee this project. He arranged to have a traveling trophy made and it was donated to the U.S.C.A. It was available at the 2004 USCA National Canoe Championships. Liquori calls this project, "YEA". A YEA committee was formed to develop the rules and criteria for selecting the recipient of this award which are listed below. The Youth Activities Committee members serve on this committee.

Nominations will be submitted, **in writing**, to the committee no later than the end of the awards ceremony on Saturday, the second day of the U.S.C.A. National Canoe and Kayak Marathon Championships.

The YEA committee will make their decision based on the information they receive on the person or persons nominated to determine who has done the most during the year to encourage, develop, and promote youth participation in the sport of competitive marathon paddling.

The recipient will be announced at the beginning of the Sunday awards ceremony and will receive the Youth Encouragement Award traveling trophy. This recipient also has the privilege to designate a youth paddler to receive a free U.S.C.A. Junior membership for the following year. The recipient will inform the U.S.C.A. Membership chairperson the name of this youth so that the official information can be obtained.

The following year when the traveling trophy is returned at the U.S.C.A. National Marathon Championships, the recipient will receive a plaque in recognition of the contribution they made to Encourage Youth into Paddling.

BILL KLEBE GOOD SPORTSMANSHIP AWARD

On January 10, 1999 at the Annual meeting held in Rochester, NY, the St. Charles Canoe Club, St. Charles, IL (a USCA Club Affiliate) proposed that they would like to sponsor an annual award at the National Championships to encourage "Good Sportsmanship" in honor of Bill Klebe. The proposal was unanimously approved. Bill was an active member of the St. Charles Canoe Club until his death in 1984 from cancer. Bill and his wife Jean were very active racers and **Good Sportsmanship** was one of his major characteristics. It is only fitting that an award of this nature be given to a person who shows outstanding sportsmanship like conduct during the week of the USCA Nationals. The traveling trophy was donated to the USCA along with a fund to maintain this award.

Eligibility: Any USCA member who has shown outstanding sportsmanship during the week of the USCA National Canoe and Kayak Championships is eligible to receive this award. The award can be given to any individual, any age or sex, not necessarily a competitor in the events.

The Selection Committee consists of the USCA Executive Committee, the USCA Executive Director and a representative from the St. Charles Canoe Club.

The traveling trophy will be presented by the USCA President during the Sunday awards ceremony of the USCA National Championships.

The procedure will be that the award will be announced in the *USCA Canoe News* magazine and placed on the semiannual meeting agenda under New Business. The Secretary of the Association shall announce to the attendees that **written** nominations shall be received by the Secretary of the Association and the Executive Director until the start of the awards presentation, Saturday, second day of the Marathon event. Nominations must describe the sportsmanship act that qualifies for this award. (If an outstanding act of sportsmanship occurs during Sunday's events, this person or persons will be considered.) The Executive Director will coordinate all information with the media.

MIKE FREMONT CONSERVATION AWARD

This special award was approved by the USCA Board of Directors at the 1992 Semianual Meeting. To be eligible for this award an organization or individual must have made an outstanding effort, nationally or internationally, toward river conservation. The USCA Executive Committee will accept nominations and administer this award with the assistance of Mike, himself.

This conservation award is named in honor of longtime canoe racer and river conservation activist, Leonard H. (Mike) Fremont from Cincinnati, Ohio, for his many years of dedication to the preservation of the nation's waterways. Mike founded the Ohio based *Rivers Unlimited* and was instrumental in the formation of the national conservation group, *American Rivers*. In 1993, the USCA Executive Board (Delegates), awarded Honorary Life Membership in the Association to our canoeing friend and long time USCA member.

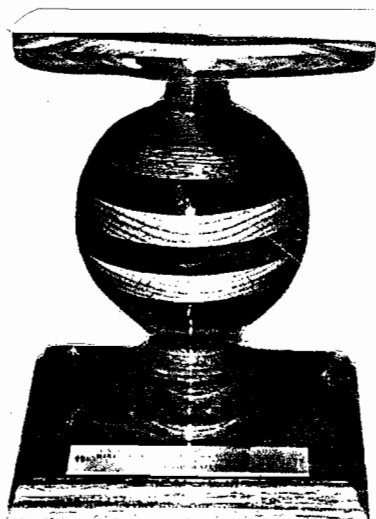
The **AWARD** was especially designed and approved by Mike. It was handcrafted from a block of wood made of alternating horizontal layers of light and dark hardwoods and carved into the shape of a large sphere representing the "world". Jay Behling from Lititz, PA made this unique trophy. A C-1 canoe sits atop the "world" which represents Mike's continued involvement in canoe racing. He hopes to encourage a "super" veteran age class at the Nationals for the over 70 category. With his determination, we are sure there will be.

At the 1999 Nationals, the C-1 Man "Grand Veteran" (over 70) class was established as a trial in the USCA Marathon Championships. Three participated including Mike.

In 2002, the C-1 Man Grand Veteran class achieved Championship status in Marathon. Mike was one of the six who participated. (In 2004, there were eleven participants and Mike was in the field. In 2006, the field was separated into two Grand Veteran divisions, Grand Veteran 1 for 70-74 and Grand Veteran 2 for 75+ paddlers. Mike raced in the Grand Veteran 2 events in 2006, 2007 and 2008. In 2009, he was recognized as the fastest over 80 year old paddler in C-1 Grand Vet and his work in conservation.

OUTSTANDING PADDLER OF THE YEAR AWARD

In 1982, the idea to recognize a U.S.C.A. member annually at the Marathon Nationals was conceived by members of the Pennsylvania Association of Canoeing and Kayaking (PACK) and the Tiadaghton Elm Classic Race at Jersey Shore, PA. At the 1982 Nationals, this prestigious traveling trophy was donated to the U.S.C.A. to recognize an **OUTSTANDING CANOEIST OF THE YEAR**. Representatives from both the Tiadaghton Elm Classic and P.A.C.K. along with the USCA Executive Committee formulated the rules for eligibility for the award and participated in the selection process. Eventually, the USCA assumed all selection and administration duties. In 2007, the award was renamed to the Outstanding **PADDLER** of the Year.

For many years, Mary Ann Rankinen, representing Tiadaghton Elm Classic, provided the engraving for the award and gave the recipient a plaque when they returned the traveling trophy at the next Nationals. Over the years, this practice was discontinued.

Who is eligible to be a candidate for this award? Any U.S.C.A member who has made a significant contribution toward the sport of canoeing/kayaking through USCA within the current year. Also, the selection will be based on the individual's mental attitude, fellowship, spirit, sportsmanship, compassionate understanding and contribution to the promotion and growth of the amateur canoeing and kayaking cause either on a competitive and/or non-competitive basis. It is suggested that this award not be given to anyone posthumously. There is no limit to the number of times a USCA member may receive this award.

The Selection Committee is the USCA Executive Committee and the USCA Executive Director.

The USCA President shall award this trophy on Sunday of the USCA Nationals at the beginning of the Awards presentation.

The following procedure is used: The Paddler/Canoeist of the Year Award is to be placed on the Semiannual Meeting agenda under New Business. The Secretary of the Association shall announce to the Delegates that nominations will be received by the Secretary of the Association, **IN WRITING**, until the start of the Awards presentation, Saturday, second day of the marathon events. (Any one may nominate a member, therefore, the announcement for nominees may be placed in the *USCA Canoe News* in or prior to the Nationals edition.) The USCA Executive Director coordinates all media information.

THE LABRANT AWARD

The "**LaBrant Award for Outstanding Contributions to the Sport of Canoeing**" was established at the 1980 USCA Annual Meeting as a joint project of the USCA and the Lafayette (IN) Canoe Club. Nominations for the award were solicited from both the canoeing public and the industry, nationally and internationally. Originally, the selection panel was made up of the USCA Executive Committee and two designees of the Lafayette Canoe Club who determined the winner. In 1989, the Lafayette Canoe Club dissolved and the USCA Executive Committee assumed complete administration of this award. The USCA Executive Director has the responsibility to solicit for and the acceptance of nominations. (The exact procedure is available from the Executive Director.) The Executive Committee selects the winner. A special presentation of the award is made at a USCA Annual meeting. (This is not to conflict with the Mike Fremont Conservation Award presentation.)

The **AWARD**, a limited edition print by a nationally known outdoor artist, Fred Montague. It is entitled "Quiet Passage" a scene depicting a couple paddling leisurely on an idealized river. Montague was a professor in the School of Forestry, Purdue University at Lafayette, Indiana when the Lafayette Canoe Club commissioned him to do this picture. Montague was an avid painter of wildlife and used his Northern wilderness experiences to paint this picture.

This award is named in honor of the late Howie LaBrant - avid competitor, canoe and equipment designer, engineer, teacher, and former member of the Lafayette Canoe Club. LaBrant was one of the founders of the United States Canoe Association, became the Association's first Historian. He was awarded an Honorary Life Membership of the USCA in January of 1979 in recognition of a lifetime of service to the sport of canoeing. Howie died in November of 1979, but through this award, Howie's interest and love of paddling lives on

HISTORIAN'S COMMENTS

The *Historian's Record* has been compiled as a service and serves as a valuable compact resource for our members and others who want or need to know more about our Association. This *Record* includes information on past and current Officers and Committee Chairs; sites and dates of the USCA Annual Meetings; and sites and dates of the National Marathon Canoe & Kayak Championships. The *Record* indicates when each event was added as well as the Championships for Triathlon, Orienteering, Adult Sprints, Youth Sprints and Outriggers for the able bodied and the disabled. National Champions are listed by year under the event in which they competed. The number underlined indicates the number of participants in that Championship event. Even though some Championships or events have been deleted, they are still listed. This is mainly for historical purposes. Included is a brief summary of the rules for various special awards that are offered by the USCA as well as a list of the recipients.

The list of championship events is arranged sequentially. This way one is able to see the year the event was approved and added to the schedule. Several events have been approved, deleted, then reapproved or have remained deleted. Several events were renamed. This *Record* shows these changes. If there is a revolving trophy for a Championship event, the year it was received is recorded along with the name/s of the donor/s.

Numerous increases in the number of events have occurred since 2004. In that year, the Delegates approved that women would have an equal number of championship opportunities as the men. This also changed the Adult/Youth and Adult/Junior events to change the "adult" to man and woman for each category. In 2006, the five year increment rule was started for the Veteran and Grand Veteran classes across the board for men and women. The Veteran (60-69) class has been changed to Veteran 1, 60+ and Veteran 2, 65+. The Grand Veteran (70-79+) is now Grand Veteran 1, 70+ and Grand Veteran 2 is 75+. The plus is because one paddler must be in the age group listed, but the second could be older, but not younger. Paddlers can race to their disadvantage. The Delegates also approved there would be special recognition for all 80+ paddlers in all events and recognize the *fastest* 80+ paddler no matter in what event he/she raced. This age group is called the Grand Master Veteran. (See Page 24 for the "fastest 80+" winners.) In 2009, the Delegates approved Championship status for the age groups from Master to Grand Veteran 2 for both men and women in the following kayak classes: Touring, Sea Kayak and Unlimited. (See Page 25 for the results).

In 2006, the Delegates required that the Historian record the winners of the Barton Cup Challenge for Junior C-1 and K-1 paddlers in the annual *Historian's Record*. This event had started in 2000 and the old records were not complete. It

was difficult to identify the **qualified** participants and the actual BCC winners. The known information is recorded on Page 33. There are still some blanks to fill. Anyone who can supply the missing information, please contact the Historian.



The future format of the *Historian's Record* will need to be changed. As the years have passed, the number of events have increased and just trying to record a sequential list of 44 years of Marathon Champions has meant going into a supplement page and pasting it in at the bottom. Well, even this method has now got me down to the bottom of the page for this booklet. I am now at 44 pages plus cover and I am about to the quota of pages for this size of booklet. Since this is an Historical Record of so many events of this Association, to delete some areas would not be a appropriate.

I have started to transfer all the Historian's data from my old computer with its Microsoft DOS program to MSWord2003. I hope to produce the next edition from a Publisher program. I don't know whether it will be some type of a booklet form or what. I will have to see what my options are. Converting and installing all this data into the Laptop was the easy part. Now, everything needs to be reformatted file by file, page by page. It will take a lot of time but my goal for 2011 will be to produce the next Historian's Record through the new process. Another reason to transfer these files at this time was so that all the Historical information would be available in a format that anyone else would be able to use for the future data entries.

2011 will be the 44th year since the formation of the United States Canoe Association. There have been many changes since 1968 and I am sure there will be many changes in 2011 for me to report to you next year and in the future.
